Brief View

The town of Ivano-Frankivsk is situated in the Western part of Ukraine. It was founded in 1662 and has 205,000 inhabitants.

Travel

By train - from the stations Lviv (135 km) or Kyiv (600 km).

By plane - from Kyiv (arrival at 21:10).

Climate

Climate is mild with moderate precipitations. The average temperature in December is from -3 to +3°C.

Currency

Hryvna is the national Ukrainian currency. 1 US Dollar is equal to 7,95 hryvna, 1 Euro-10,5 UAH.

Leisure and entertainment

Ivano-Frankivsk is an old town which is buried in verdure most of the year. People of different ages and interests will find something for themselves in the town - quiet cafes, restaurants, nightclubs, cinemas, theatre, museums etc.

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
